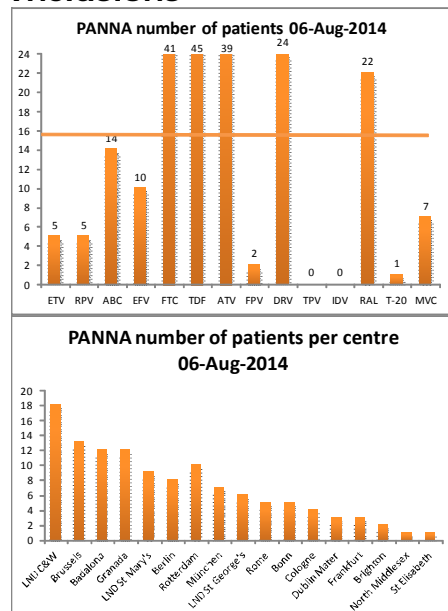

PUBLICATIONS and PLANS

Atazanavir paper has been accepted by Antiviral Therapy and is published online. We have received reviewer comments on the darunavir manuscript from JAC, and we have submitted the raltegravir manuscript.

CROI 2015

We are working on a joint abstract on etravirine data with IMPAACT, Brookie Best from IMPAACT will take the lead.

A joint manuscript (with IMPAACT) on maraviroc will be prepared by our group this year.

Pepe Moltó and Marta Valle are working on a population PK model for darunavir during pregnancy, using the PANNA data.

Physiologically Based PK modelling is being worked on by Angela in collaboration with Rick Greupink of the department of Pharmacology/toxicology of the Radboudumc. The project is called PIANO, a grant of the Dutch government has been received for the project. PANNA data will be used for validation.

A PhD student: Stein Schalkwijk will work on this project (and also be involved in PANNA) from October 1st onwards.
