Belgium: working on submission.

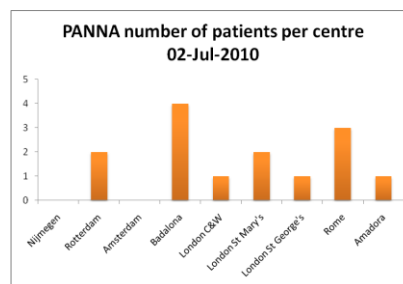
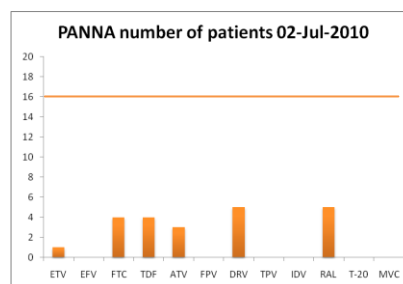
Canada: a grant has been assigned, ethics submission will start.
